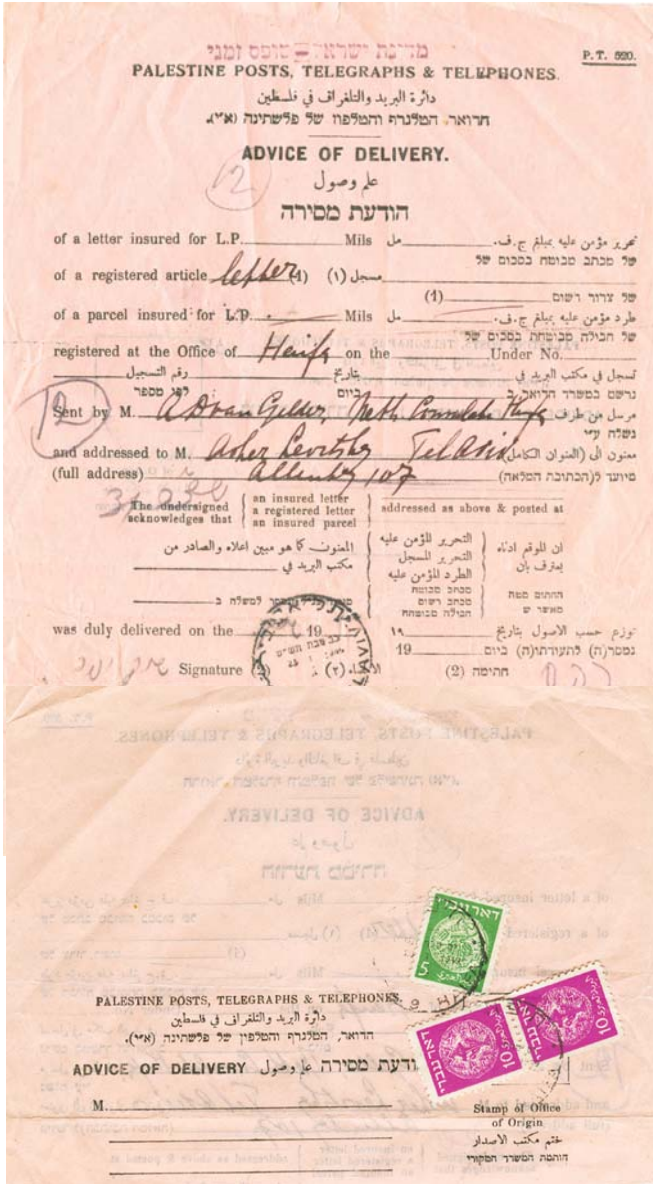


# Franked Forms (Other Postal Stationery)

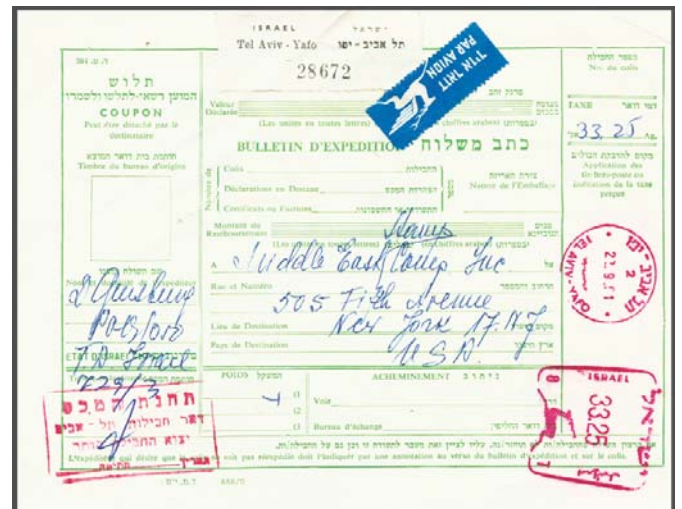
Packet delivery from Haifa to Tel Aviv on 23 January 1949 franked with 25m Doar ivri stamps.



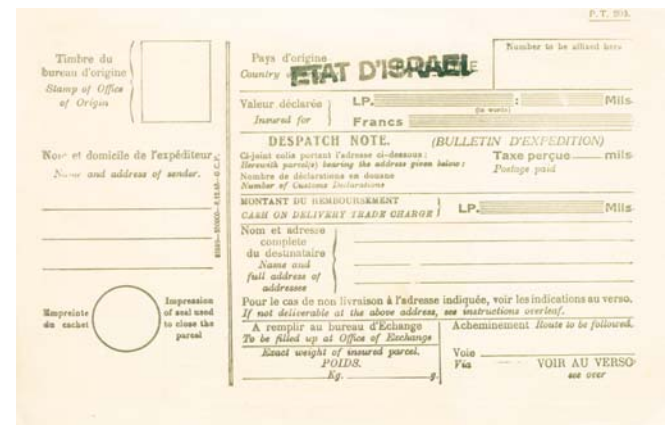
26 October 1949 postal receipt: charge of 80m for transferring 12 Li
