## EC Event Commemoration Publications

### EC Definition

Envelopes, cards, folders or sheets pre-printed with design commemorating an event and stamps affixed and tied with a postal Cancellation of the actual date of the event. It may have a regular date postmark or a fancy commemorative cancellation prepared by the IPS. This wide definition covers a large range of items prepared throughout the years either by the IPS, institutions, official bodies or private publishers.

DC - stands for EC Decorated Covers

### EC Postmarks

The IPS has policy of preparing special designed commemorative postmarks for national or important events. These postmarks are decorated with a logo or a design symbolizing the event. All Pmk's include the name of the event and date. Listing of these fancy postmarks can be found in the IPS Catalogue of EC markings).

The commemorative Pmk's are of two origins: A. Pmk's decided by the IPS (mostly national events).

B. Pmk's ordered by official institutions (against fee). The fee for ordering C-Pmk's was raised dramatically (about 1985). Therefore, not all major events in Israel were commemorated with such postmarks during the nineties

### Bale Catalogue presentation

This chapter's purpose is to introduce to the reader a brief overview of EC type of publications. As there are thousands of items and no research on this topic, Bale introduces just main groups of publications. Some groups may contain many hundreds of different issues that are not listed in this edition in details.

### Philatelic Items

All these publications are known as "philatelic items", prepared by dealers or semi-official bodies as presents or for commercial purposes. They were published either by the IPS or by private publishers, and are regarded neither as "traditional philately" or as "postal history". Nevertheless, they are "collectibles" and in many ways describe important events in the development of the State of Israel in science, commerce, industry and social development.

### Classification of EC's

The classification of EC's may be done by appearance, publisher and mainly by topic.

## DCO DC for Post Office Openings

The opening of new post offices in 1948 had a symbolic meaning as being a part of the new established State of Israel and a cause for celebration. Collectors of the period were keen on covers with the "First Day of the Post" of various locations. Later, the IPS provided a collectors' service for such covers, a service which exists to this day. The P.O. openings postmarks are classified into the following groups of interest:

1. 1948-1950 postmarks. These were of openings of all major towns and cities (as well as smaller localities)
2. 1951 and later openings
3. 1957 openings in the Gaza strip
4. 1967-2000 openings in Judea, Samaria and Gaza strip

Groups 3 & 4 represent postal history of occupied territories. Listing of all postal openings can be found in IPS publications.

1. Registered covers: refers to properly franked with R-label of the locality and actually mailed
2. The IPS covers are usually plain, with IPS logo, Decorated covers may be different sizes and privately published. There were several publisher for 6 Days War Victory covers.

**DCT.01 Decorated Covers Flight events (DCF)**

Since Israel was under siege during the war of independence, all foreign links were either by sea or air. The various airlines Cancelled their connection to Israel due to security or political reasons, so that only "non-official" hired flights could support the emergency needs of the state in war. As well as cargo, these flights also took mail to and from Israel. Such covers are in demand by specialists and are from US\$50.00 (plain commercial covers. See in "Rates & Postal History"). The first "official flight cachet" was prepared late as June 10th 1948 to commemorate the first flight to France (even though un-official flights operated earlier).

## SL Decorated Folders & Cards

The SL category refers to illustrated printed productions which are not envelopes, but postcards, leaflets, folders, cards etc in various dimensions commemorating actual events, using the stamps tied with the special postal EC cachet or the actual date postmark of the event's day. There are thousands of such productions prepared by IPS, semi official bodies as well as private publishers. The classification of these productions can be done by topic (like DC) as well as in printing series as following:

- SLA. Non standard designs and sizes (from 1948 onwards)
- SLB. Souvenir Leaves - Pre-printed cards (from 1988) consistent design
- CLC. New Year souvenir cards to subscribers of IPS
- SLD. Maximum Cards
